



Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:00:17) - Well, greetings and salutations and welcome once again to just common sense taken from Proverbs two seven.

Pat Hunter (00:00:24) - He grants a treasure of common sense to the honest. He is a shield to those who walk with integrity.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:00:31) - And it's wonderful being with everyone today. And we have some wonderful headlines to get into. But before I even get into the headlines and anything else today, uh, we're going to do a little change here. Uh, we actually have our guest, Lance Reves's, back with us again. And the reason he's back with us is, you know, we had, uh, Carl's Astro on the program, and it was amazing that they were using the Civil Rights Act that actually come after people that are trying to save lives and interposing themselves. Well, that trial has been going on for a week now. But just as we were getting ready to record this program, Lawrence called in and I said, wait a minute, let's go on line with it right now.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:01:14) - And we have with us Lawrence Reves. Uh, he called in to let us know that the trial has actually reached a verdict. Lawrence, are you calling in from Florida? Uh, today. And, uh, welcome back to the program.

Lawrence Reves (00:01:31) - Well, thank you for having me. I didn't expect to be here.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:01:35) - Uh, I know also. So tell us what what happened and how you found out and where everybody's can find out what's happening.

Lawrence Reves (00:01:43) - Well, one of the people that was being, uh, pursued by the Biden administration was, uh, Dennis Green and, uh, Dennis, cancer survivor. And he had been, uh, along with the others trying to save children and their mothers at, uh, one of the abortion mills there.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:02:01) - Now, when you.

Lawrence Reves (00:02:01) - Kind of see.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:02:02) - That, uh, a lot of people may not know about Dennis Green. Now, Dennis Green has been a pro-life advocate for many, many years, a solid Christian man, one that even make pastors repent.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:02:12) - Uh, you know, he's a very dedicated to Lord, end up with a strong case of cancer and, uh, actually got treatment. And I think he even went out of the country to get treatment, didn't he?

Lawrence Reves (00:02:24) - Yes. He went to Mexico.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:02:25) - Yes. And now he's a real survivor, and he's living well, nevertheless. Um, he is one of the many people named in this case as Carl's Astro. And a lot of the others, even idol in the whole company, um, who was a survivor of the Holocaust and. Right. Okay, so so Nanavati has come in.





Lawrence Reves (00:02:49) - The verdict, he's come in. They had two counts against them and they were found guilty on both counts. Uh, the next phase will be sentencing. Uh, I'm not sure exactly when that will be yet. That that hasn't been discussed. Might have been in a courtroom, but it hasn't been released publicly. Yes.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:03:09) - Now, for those who may be just hearing about this for the first time, they might not have been listening to just common sense, um, often.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:03:16) - So, uh, give, give them a rundown of how this case started. Um.

Lawrence Reves (00:03:22) - Well, there used to be the we talked about when you and I talked before, we talked about the concept of rescue, which is to intercede for the lives of the children and their mothers, uh, the unborn children. These people did that at an abortion mill. Uh, they were tried in Tennessee by, uh, the federal government. And as you said, you have a Holocaust survivor, you have a cancer survivor. You have numerous people who have been involved through the Lord for years. And they interceded at the door. And that means that anyone could go, could come out that wanted to. But to go in, you had to step over these people and they what they did was saying and prayed and tried to, uh, appeal to the mothers so their children could continue to live. Well, they were arrested under the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances Act is called and, uh, this is a federal law.

Lawrence Reves (00:04:33) - And they were tried and convicted.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:04:37) - Wow. Now, now, Tammy, was everyone blocking the doors? I understand there was a negotiator who was talking with the police officer, and he wasn't blocking it, and it wasn't doing anything. He was just standing in the hallway talking with the officers. And I understand he was charged with the same thing.

Lawrence Reves (00:04:53) - I am not clear on that. Uh, however, from past experience, if it was a negotiator, most likely it was the former policeman, Chet Gallagher, because he's usually the one that does that kind of thing with the police.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:05:07) - Yeah, I'm not sure it was Chet this time, but, um, but I remember. Carlson. It was it was very extraordinary for such a person to be charged with the same thing they were. Now, I understand that they did this years ago. Right?

Lawrence Reves (00:05:24) - Well, uh, the rescue was just a few years ago. Yes, a couple of years ago. Um.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:05:31) - And then it's the Biden administration that actually jumped back into the Justice Department, jumped in and put those charges out.

Lawrence Reves (00:05:38) - Right, right. Uh, and again, it's under the freedom of access to clinic Information, uh, Clinic Entrances Act, which supposedly, uh, protects hospitals and churches, but it never seems to be used for anyone who attacks churches.





Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:05:55) - Wow. Wow. Wow. So, folks, we need to do some serious praying here. And, um, uh, Lawrence, can you tell people how they can find that information?

Lawrence Reves (00:06:10) - Well, I found out specifically on Facebook, uh, Dennis Greene is a Facebook friend of mine, as, uh, as well as he was a counselor for us with my wife's, uh, most recent two bouts with cancer. And matter of fact, she went to the same clinic he did in, uh, in Mexico. And he donated some equipment to my wife for her help here. Uh, so I checked. I've been checking Astros Facebook page because I'm friends with him and also Dennis Greene. My wife informed me that Dennis Greene had the notation on there, that the verdicts were reached.

Lawrence Reves (00:06:50) - Guilty on both counts. And that was this morning that it was announced. Wow.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:06:56) - Wow. Now, folks, you're talking about things. Turn it upside down. This is one of them. This is this is where somebody is working to save lives. They are facing some major jail time. Um, I could have easily have pulled up if you look through the news, things that are out there, there are situations, uh, where they've now caught another illegal immigrant. This time he was beating up somebody else and robbing somebody else. He was part of a robbery team and was the third time he had been captured. Um, and even though ice acts that he, uh, be detained because he's in the sanctuary city, they're not honoring their recommendation. So he got somebody here robbing people, beating people, and they they're walking around free. And he has some people who literally impose themselves between what the abortionist was going to do and, and, and them said they put their life on the line, and now they are facing some major prison time just for saving children.

Lawrence Reves (00:07:57) - Well, the worst thing is, yeah, one of the worst things is that they're using the concept of civil rights to actually come against the pro-lifers. Uh, the which is ironic because from the beginning, as you and I both know, Planned Parenthood has been going against, uh, uh, the black community and all the minorities, as a matter of fact, including poor whites and targeting them. Mhm.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:08:29) - Um.

Lawrence Reves (00:08:31) - Now they're saying that, oh, these people are being racist. Da da da da da da da da da. Well, that's so much hokum. Yes. And if you ever actually met the pro-lifers, those that, uh, have met the pro-lifers know that this is anything but the truth. Amen.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:08:50) - Amen. And I try to share about it. Abortion itself takes away every civil rights you could ever have. You know, in other words, dear child, voting rights mean nothing to a dead child. Right, exactly. A good education means nothing to a dead child. Uh, my wonderful, even birthday party means nothing to a dead child.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:09:13) - A safe playground means nothing to a dead child. Anything you could think of that's under the Civil Rights Act. Means nothing. If you can kill the child while the child is still in the womb. And, uh, this is in, uh, in in, I tell you. You know, I've been in places where we've actually saved a child, and, um. It's a grand feeling when you see that child is born and that child is older. Yes, I remember I preached at a church one time in Buffalo, New York, and and at church I preached a





message, you know, who knows who your child is to become? And all throughout Scripture you can tell when a child was in the mother's womb. You know, I remember, you know, if you study closely, Esau and Jacob, they wrestled in the womb. And and God reminded him that, hey, that's two nations in your womb. Yes. It wasn't just the two children, it was two nations in that one, you know.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:10:05) - So even in the womb to who the child was and what they would be, it was already there. And, um, and I remember the young lady, uh, she went out of town to go get her abortion and somehow know that that message that I preach was ringing through her, and she said why she was on there. She said she laid down, she got up, took off her clothes and everything. It was put on their little gowns and, and laid down in this seat. And she said, oh, even on that table on an abortion table, she could still hear the words, who knows who your child is to become. It was just ringing through a heart of mine, and abortions finally came. He said, where are you ready? And she said, who knows, my child is coming. She stood up and she got dressed. She left. She loved him. She didn't take her money back enough. She got out of there. Yes. Amen. And I had the privilege of not only, um, that that young lady giving a life over to the Lord at our church, but even had the chance of just dedicating her child to the Lord after he was born.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:11:02) - Amen.

Lawrence Reves (00:11:03) - Oh praise God.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:11:04) - Yes. You know and and I can't tell you of all the things in my life I've done that was the most precious to me, you know that I you know a lot of things preachers do that are nice, but some things are just outright good. And that was one of them. And God used me at that moment with that particular message. And in another church, you know, you know, is is so, so when you hear people trying to use civil rights in order to murder child as if that's your civil rights to murder somebody else, oh my goodness, they might would just I'm glad if you went around doing the lunchtime. Do you realize what they would have said? It's okay for mobs to lynch people you know. Yes.

Lawrence Reves (00:11:49) - Oh yeah. Well they, they use you know, they, they constantly are saying that we are the oppressors, meaning the pro-lifers because we're keeping, uh, I don't want to just concentrate on black people, but, uh, minorities from quote unquote accessing their civil rights.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:12:10) - Yes, majorly. Now, now, I want to tell you something. Regardless how this case turns out. Now, now, not the case when they do the sentencing, uh, the fight still doesn't stop there. And this is something everybody has has got to realize, even when it appears that you lose, you keep hanging on God. God can still intervene. Yes. In the worst of situations, God can still step in. And so many times in the scripture when you read it, it looks like the enemy was winning. And uh, the main thing was when Jesus Christ was on Calvary's cross and when he hung his head, I know the enemy probably thought he had really won. And, uh, no, it was at that point that I was sins forgiven. Yes, a whole new thing could come in and we fell out. We were under grace. Jesus died for me and for you. He shed his blood for all of us. And the one thing he did, he got victory over death itself because it could not hold him.





Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:13:13) - Amen. Next to that grave couldn't hold him. And so. And so we got to realize, as bad as it may seem right now, as Christians, we're going to hold on. Yes, because the battle is not over yet. Amen. Exactly, exactly, lt's not over yet.

Lawrence Reves (00:13:32) - If you remember what happened, uh, when Operation Rescue was in Buffalo, and, uh, the people that were arrested under, uh, Judge Vickery, I think his name was.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:13:44) - Yes. I remember back.

Lawrence Reves (00:13:46) - There, they tried to get us all to make deals, and, uh, I got released halfway through the trial. Um, everybody else wound up getting, uh, being found guilty and sentenced. But on appeal, everybody's case was thrown out, and they were all exonerated. Yes, yes. And this was because they continued to fight. They did not compromise.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:14:15) - And yes. And it's also important not only did everybody win except for one person vestry, because the next time he ran for judge, he was defeated.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:14:25) - And that man had been serving for years. And when and after years and the pro-choice community got behind him, and hell, a great big, uh, thing for him in. Raising all this stuff and he still loss and they believe it or not, he was shocked when he lost. You know, I have no doubt. Yeah. Hey, man. Yeah.

Lawrence Reves (00:14:47) - We usually are shocked when they see the Lord actually move against them because they don't expect that.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:14:52) - Yes, yes. Well, I tell you that there are some things that are going on today, and I. Lawrence, I want to thank you for being on the program up front. And I'm going to go ahead and go through some other things that are coming around, because God is getting ready to turn things around. The best part about it that that that the real blessing that people need to realize, there's people like you, you see right through it. You are Christian. And I mean, you are saying and everything else out there right now is insanity is going out of the room.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:15:24) - And, uh, but there are people God has to see right through it. And the audience that is only listening to this program, you are saying, whatever you do, don't lose your sanity just because things are going way out of going way out of whack. Totally turned upside down of all the times. And this when you hold on to your sanity, you have that thing called common sense. Yes.

Lawrence Reves (00:15:53) - Which is that seems so common nowadays.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:15:57) - That does not seem like it. Death does not seem like it. Well, thank you, Lawrence, for being on it. And and I'm going to be, uh, speaking with you coming up in the future some more. And, uh.

Lawrence Reves (00:16:09) - If I may, one last thing. Certainly, uh, just very quickly with that within Scripture, you talked about how it refers to the, the children every time a, an unborn child is spoken of in Scripture, the same word is used, whether unborn or born, and it always refers to alive child hmhm.





Lawrence Reves (00:16:33) - So we always have to keep that in mind. Even where two men struggle and they cause a woman who is pregnant, uh, for her child to come early.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:16:41) - Yes.

Lawrence Reves (00:16:42) - That's it. The child is born early. Not if he's killed. When he's killed, then it's eye for an eye. Tooth for a tooth.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:16:49) - Um, I want.

Lawrence Reves (00:16:49) - To clarify that.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:16:51) - Amen. Amen. And you did. I love you, and God blesses you. All right. And we'll be talking with you soon again.

Lawrence Reves (00:17:00) - All right. God bless.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:17:01) - You. God bless you. All right, folks, now, if you just had the. Okay, now, we just had the privilege to listen to Lawrence and what I like you to do. First of all, start praying and, uh, pray for them to get a victory. I know the next thing going to be sentencing. And I've seen people get victory. If you listen to one of the shows, we talk about a person who got victory in the middle of the sentencing.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:17:26) - But, uh, God is going to be doing some wonderful things. And, um, for the headlines that are going on now, right now, because I want to talk about them, and I want everyone to really realize you really need to stay sane, and you need to really push back and really fight and go forward. The, um, on a local thing we have here that's going on, I wanted to bring it up. One of the veterans places are closing down North Carolina Veterans Home that they got. They closed it, but there's still a few people left over. And, uh, it's got to be of some concern because in New York, some other places, they did close the veteran house down, but he closed it down so they can move in people that cross the border illegally so they can stay there and they put the veterans out. And you have to understand, the veterans are people who were laid down their life for us to. Yes, these are people that was willing to risk their life to help make this nation stay safe, to make sure that we kept our freedoms and our liberties, and to make sure no foreign government stepped in.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:18:35) - And now they are older. And as they're older, they need help at times, too. Um, and not only that, uh, I don't know if you've read the news, but the last three people that was killed, um, was little young warriors who was trying to protect us. And, uh, they got involved, as you know, we're talking about they're talking about what's going on with between Israel and Hamas and all. Uh, nevertheless, I ran his fingers in it, too, and actually sent out a drone that snuck on to the place where these people were injured many and killed three. Uh, and a newspaper made a big point of showing that they were people of color. But folks, it didn't matter. Amen. These were Americans? Yes. These were people that was laying down their life. They weren't going by, uh, this tone of the tone of their skin. They were actually going by their commitment to help this nation. And, um, sooner or later, we have to deal with veterans, even here in.





Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:19:41) - North Carolina. What are we going to allow them to do? And they're talking about that home. And they said it's not. They're trying to move. They move them out because they said it's just not fit. It has mold in it. And I was looking at one of the things, um, they said the cost of removing that mold was a £25 million.

Pat Hunter (00:20:01) - Yes.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:20:02) - We're talking about millions of dollars, millions of dollars. But I love the way the zydeco kind of end up. And this is one of the thing people asking, where can I get news from? Where can City View? Uh, here in favor of North Carolina locally is one of the best places you can find out what's going on, too. It's a local thing. I won't say they're biased one way or the other, but if you want to know what's happening locally, City View is is a good paper to get your fingers on. And if you don't have the paper on the magazine, you can always go online.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:20:37) - It says in the final part of the article said a former employee did not see the roof as an insurmountable issue, necessitating the facility's abandonment. But more of a financial burden for DMV and the prudent health may not want to take care of, he said, because that's a big fairy tale, they said. He said that facility is not in bad shape. So so here we have somebody that was there, you know, their opinion a little bit different. And it should count also. There's a couple of programs I'm going to I'm going to get ready for, because we're going to need to bring Doctor Diggs in a cup of medical expertise back on. We got to get the bioethics scientists and doctor back into um, there's a little mention that came up. The CDC put out a study and the CDC, they linked their study that blames the increase of deaths. I don't know if you noticed or not, but the number of deaths from people having cardiovascular disease has gone far up. There's a lot of people just dropping from having a heart attack.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:21:51) - Um, well, they are saying that it has to do with everything that they said is related to stress and Covid, but nowhere did they mention to him or any vaccines. And they published all the published in the American Journal for Preventive Medicine. Blame the paradigm rise in US cardiovascular disease, death rate on destruction in access to health care, stress and the lingering effects of Covid 19. But the widely promoted article did not discuss existing scientific evidence linking the vaccines to heart issues. The heart issues impact. You want to talk? Uh, John Michael Dumas was the editor for that one. Uh, that's coming from a site called a defender.

Pat Hunter (00:22:46) - Okay. He he's been a writer and community organizer, Mr. John. Michael. Um, Dumas. Um, he's the, um, a variety of issues, including death penalty, war, health, freedom and all kinds of relative, um, things related to the Covid pandemic. This was Doctor Michael DeMoss.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:23:12) - Yes. And DeMoss did this, and he wrote that article.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:23:16) - Yes. Um, and but but then you got to understand something.

Pat Hunter (00:23:23) - Which is.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:23:23) - Right. They named everything, but the vaccine is maybe having a cause. But they did admit one thing. The number of deaths have gone up. Yeah. And there's a little graph I have. That's kind of disturbing. The quarterly excess of deaths in the in the deaths for the country, United





States of America. And this is the age group between 25 and 44. It has gradually gone up. And it didn't start when Covid kicked in. It started after the vaccine came out. That's what makes the up things so interesting. The, um. I'm looking at a graph, and the graph shows what starts with 2020, in the fourth month, and in the fourth quarterly, it shows the numbers down there very low. The percentage of people, the population that really was had things. But it goes up in the first quarter of 21. It goes higher in the second quarter, and it goes even higher on the third quarter of 21.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:24:41) - And by the time we get to 24, it's going up and up and up. And uh, and since you can't watch, see the graph with me as a, as going up and as almost leveling off, but it's very far up there. And, um, there's another little table that says in a quarterly that analyzing in 2020, they talk about the excess mortality percentage by quarter. In other words, oh, average number of people dying, more dying or less dying in the year 2020. That was less. It was a -4%. That was the different population. You know, they said it was like 16. Uh, group life was 16% US population of 20%. Third quarter 2020. Yeah. It started rising somewhat by the time it got to 2020. That fourth quarter was talking about it was a 2%. In other words, 2%. More people died from mortality. So something something kicked in, 2% died more than usual. By 21, it was 6% died more than usual. In 2021, it was still at 1%.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:25:58) - But in the third quarter of 2021, 10% more people die than ever. And you gotta understand how scientists think even a 1% is a chance. Saying something way off here, something's really wrong. That thing has jumped as high as 10%. And yet they're saying they're not. They're saying, well, it has to do with stress. And people didn't get access. But rather than me talking about it, that's where we have to bring the main people on. Let Doctor Diggs say something about it. Here's the thing about it that.

Pat Hunter (00:26:29) - Yes, doctor, the the smartest doctor in the world, I love it.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:26:36) - Okay. Now, Doctor Brenda Poletti also did a, uh, another thing. There's something coming out for children. Now, this one wasn't put out by the CDC, but this is a group called the defenders. And this group of scientists, they are calling for a global moratorium for the RNA vaccines. They want immediate removal from childhood schedule. And this just came out at the end of January.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:27:14) - Um, they point the article came out gender at the 29th of this year, and they did a review, and they found out that the number of injuries from this vaccine is way up.

Pat Hunter (00:27:26) - Yes.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:27:27) - And what they and those injuries, um, uh, far outweigh the benefits. And what they call them is, uh, you're going to hear a little phrase called says S.A.S. and C stands for Serious Adverse Event. Um, and uh, the paper that they put out has sold the review. The first reports from vaccine trials claim they were 95% effective on preventing Covid serious problems with the method execution reported in trials became public when the paper was reviewed in detail. In other words, when peers, other doctors and professionals looked at that study, said, whoa, this is way off. When it first came out, the World Health Organization said, oh, it's 95%, in fact, 95. And, um, I have a little things here. Somebody wrote out a little case. They noticed something in me.





Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:28:27) - We were being told by all these health care professionals from World Health Organization. They put out little things that the vaccine itself was 95% protection in June. Well, it was down to 70% protection by May. By July, it was only 50% protection by the time August kicked in, when at the time, we was talking about when things start to happen in there, no protection. But they said it reduces the spread. And you were told that, and then you remember after that when that didn't work, come around about September, they said, well, it may not reduce the spread, but it's going to reduce the severe. Two of it. And then when that didn't really work, people started spreading and getting it anyhow. Even people that already had the shots and stuff, they said, well, it doesn't reduce severity, but it reduced you from going to the hospital, keep you out. Well, it didn't keep people out of the hospital. So then they told people, don't worry. It may it may not reduce the hospital, but you're not going to die, folks.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:29:25) - Somebody had some fun with this one. They said, folks, we all, you know you'll die, but we're going to go to heaven. But somebody just had to make a joke out of it. They they said, look like everything the saying goes from bad to worse to worse. Yeah.

Pat Hunter (00:29:37) - And and this was from the World Health Organization.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:29:41) - Yes. Yes. And they kept telling you one thing, but he kept going. But you need to keep your insanity. That's what you need to do. Just maintain your consent. And don't be fooled by any other things that are going on. Meanwhile, as we close as other things that happen in two. But we're going to take some of this up to next week, because even if you watch what's happening, there's two situations that has happened. The judge has unsealed a divorce case. Uh, that had there's a you know, we got the, um, prosecutor down there in Fulton County, Miss Willis, and she's going after Trump with a vengeance.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:30:21) - All of that found out she hired her where they say was boyfriend, but actually, he was having an affair with them. And the guy had no he had no experiment experience at all in working with this type of a case. And yet they brought him on board and he was paid \$250 an hour. In other words, so far, he's earned over \$650,000 working on the Trump case with his. Now we found out his girlfriend, but actually she was having an affair. Now, if that's not scary enough, Corey Bush, they have now issued today a subpoena that comes up against her. Because if you don't remember Corbo, she's part of the group they called a squad and she's a representative from Missouri, and she's the one that was calling for defund the police. Why? She was calling for defund the police. They found that she was misusing government funds, that you can look out for her own security, hire her boyfriend, who she's now married. That was just recently. And she spent more than \$500,000 for her own private security while she was advocating defund the police.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:31:43) - So she was using our money, \$500,000 to help protect her. Yes.

Pat Hunter (00:31:49) - Okay, so.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:31:50) - Folks, when you see all of this going on, you just keep your sanity. The mere fact that some of these things are coming out now shows you that God's getting ready to turn some things around.





Speaker 5 (00:32:00) - Yes.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:32:01) - That's a little thing. I don't like it when I'm in bed because. I don't care who you are or what you're doing. There are things that are said in the dark that will come out in open.

Speaker 5 (00:32:17) - Yes.

Dr. Johnny Hunter (00:32:18) - There are things that people will do when it's time for just to come around. I don't care what they've done. Somebody is going to come out and they did it. Whatever's happening right now, God's going to return some things around you. Hold onto your sanity on a nice, clear day with the clouds in the sky.
